- Sales—Up 7.6 percent from 263 in January 2014 to 283 in January 2015.
- **Median Price** Up 3.4 percent from \$179,000 in January 2014 to \$185,000 in January 2015.
- **Inventory of available property**—Inventory is down 3.9 percent from 1,953 single family listings at the end of January 2014, to 1,877 single family listings at the end of January 2015.
- **Supply**—At the end of January 2014 there were 7.4 months of supply at the current rate of sale. At the end of January 2015 there were 6.6 months of supply at current rate of sale.
- **Days on Market**—The average days on market is up 13.8 percent from 137 days in January 2014 to 156 in January 2015.
- **Pending Sales**—Listings which are under agreement to sell are up 10.9 percent from 320 in January 2014 to 355 in January 2015.
- A Six-Year View—The median price is down 2.6 percent from \$190,000 in January 2010 to \$185,000 in January 2015.
